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### Homework

Homework will be given out every Friday. We will give the children a task with an aim or learning objective that they should reach by the following Wednesday, when homework is to be handed in. We encourage the children to be creative and present their work in any of the following ways:

- Pop-up work
- Diagrams

### Maths

Maths homework will be a consolidation/challenge of the work completed in class during the week.

### Spellings

A set of spellings according to your child's needs will be worked on at school during the week and then given for homework on a Friday. Spelling tests will be on a Monday.

### Reading

Children are expected to read every night.



### Uniform

As with the rest of the school, we expect that Year 4 will follow the uniform policy. It is essential that smart, black shoes are worn as a part of this.

PE kits form a part of what is expected of the children's uniform. Flat shoes are also essential. With swimming being our PE lesson each week, we suggest the swimming kit is brought in on Thursday and taken home again each week.

We have an extensive range of after school clubs run by teachers and external coaches. For any club, the children should wear either their school uniform or PE kit, with the addition of sports specific footwear.
