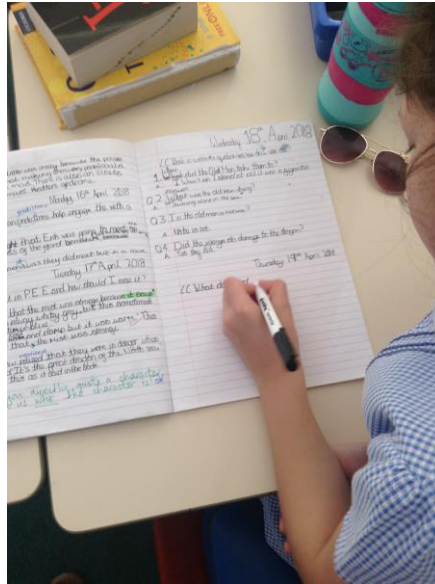
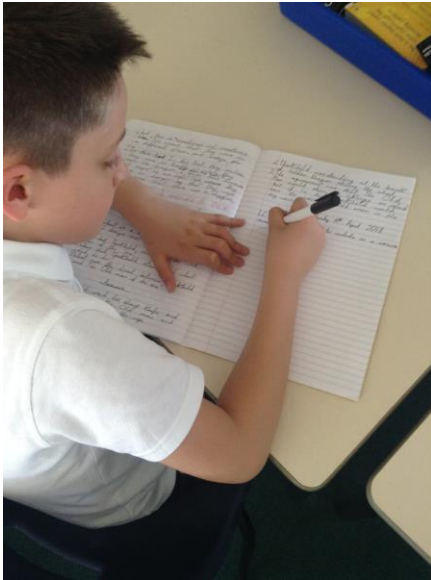
We hope you all had a wonderful Easter. We are really excited that the children are back at school and ready for a summer term full of exciting learning activities.

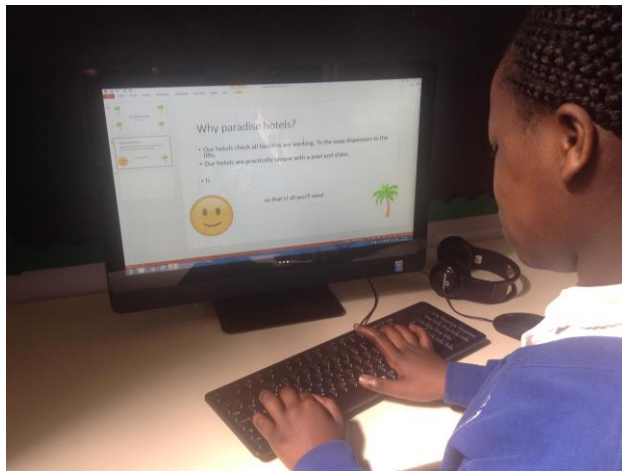

Initially, children developed their business inventions and outlined their unique selling points in order to produce a persuasive piece of writing which was to become their sales pitch.





In Maths, pupils became familiar with the terminology of business including terms such as profit and loss, budgeting, interest, expense and revenue. They also put a business plan together to set up their own tuck shops, having to calculate product costs based on warehouse prices to ensure they make a profit.

During ICT, within groups, each class prepared their presentations using Powerpoint. Their focus was on the visual elements using language to hook, engage and persuade their audience.
