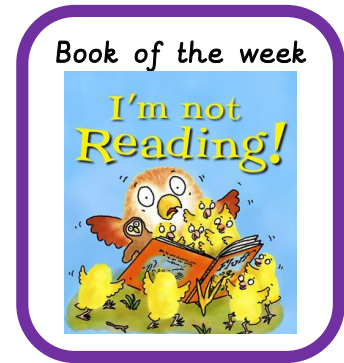

English

This week we wrote our names and everybody has made excellent progress since we first started Nursery. Most of us now know how to write our names without any help!

Science Week

It is great to announce 8 out of 10 eggs have hatched in Nursery. We got to feed and touch the chicks before they had to go home and we have enjoyed having them very much!

As it is Science week we have done lots of different experiments:

- What happens to an egg if we soak it in vinegar?
- Can I stand on eggs without them cracking?
- What happens to celery if we put them in coloured water?
- What shape bubbles come out of different shaped bubble wands?
- What material protects a falling egg best?
- What happens when you plant a bean?
- What happens when we put sugar, salt, pepper, coffee, cinnamon in water?
- What is a magnet?

Key Words: experiment, bouncy, strong, absorb, protect, plant, grow, dissolve
