We have been doing lots of mark making with sparkly glitter paint and sparkly glitter foam.



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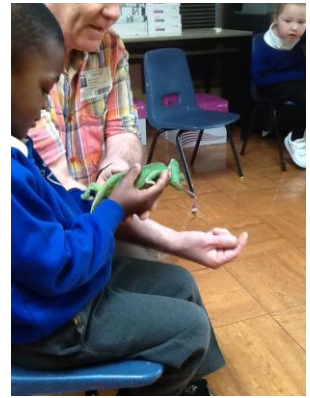
Maths
