To celebrate the Royal Wedding we have been practising our cutting skills and made lovely stick puppets.



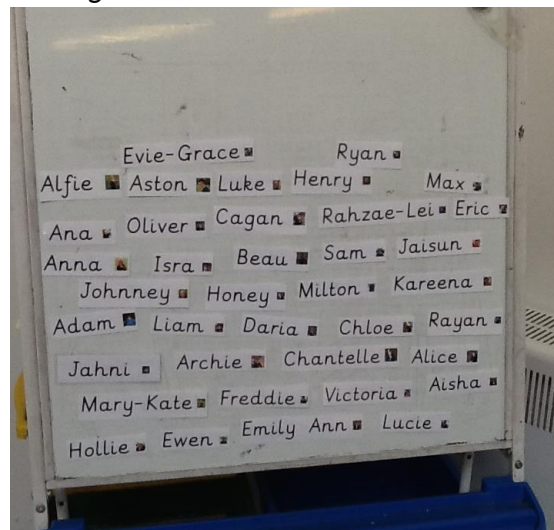
Outdoor Play
