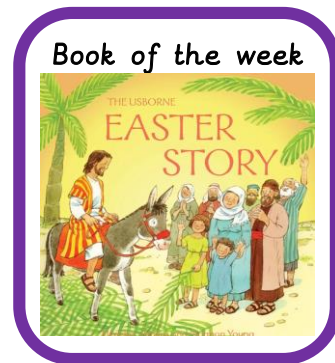


Nursery Newsletter

English/Understanding the World

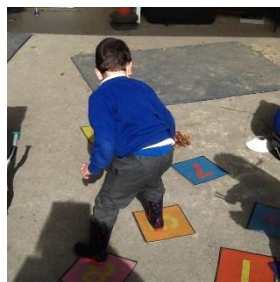
This week we read the Easter story and talked about why and how people celebrate Easter. We then practised writing Easter cards remembering to write who it is to and from.
