Our first topic is Growing.
(May - June)

This will cover some of the following:

- Listening to themed stories, acting them out and sequencing pictures
- Letter formation for flower labels
- Petal/ seed collage
- Weaving patterns
- Life cycles
- ICT photograph/ video habitats
- Number recognition, making mini beasts game with dice
- Weighing beans/ seeds
- Collage leaves/ sunflowers
- Talking about feelings- Little Red Hen
- Jim and the Beanstalk- cutting leaf shapes
- Summer 'growing' walk

Our Second topic is Senses.
(June - July)

This will cover some of the following:

- Recognise objects by senses
- Counting textured objects
- Listening, acting out a variety of stories
- Listening skills games

- Malleable materials- textures
- Summer senses walk
- Feely bags
- IPad sound, text and photographs
- Instruments, percussion
