This week in Reception we learnt about...

<u>Phonics</u>: We practised phase 2 and 3 sounds and tricky words they, was, me, be, she and could.

Literacy: We continued to learn the story 'The Bad Tempered Ladybird' and in groups the children thought of some fantastic adjectives to describe the different characters.

For science week! We had a blast doing lots of different experiments including the bouncy egg trick, we made our own giant bubbles, we coloured white flowers with different dyes and learnt about the parts of a flower.
