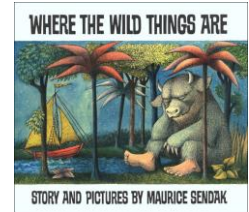


# Reception Newsletter

Dear Parents/Carers,

This week in Reception we learnt about...

**Phonics:** We revised phase 2 and 3 sounds.

**Numeracy:** The children were introduced to patterns, inside we made patterns using the pegboards. During maths learning we made 2 colour and 3 colour patterns using coloured bears.  
Key Vocabulary: pattern, colours, first, next,

**Topic:** We worked together to make giant minibeasts for our display we made a ladybird and butterfly.

**Book Week:** The children enjoyed a workshop and learnt to tell the whole story of 'Where the Wild Things are' through only using movements. The children looked fantastic dressed up they talked about who they were and their favourite book.

Next week: We are starting our new story for talk for writing 'The Bad Tempered Ladybird'

The children will be creating their own fact book for a ladybird and will learn about the lifecycle of a ladybird.

- Practise the sounds we have been learning s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k.

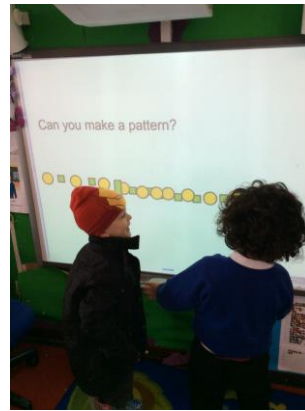
**Just a note to say:** Can all children have their P.E kit for Tuesdays. Please make sure your child's Book Bag is in each day ☺
