This week in Reception we learnt about...

<u>Phonics:</u> We all practised different sounds.

<u>Literacy:</u> We learnt about rhyming books and poems. The children wrote their own rhyming strings, matched the rhyme, wrote their own rhyme, went on a rhyming hunt and played rhyming bingo.
