This week in Reception we learnt about...

<u>Phonics</u>: We revised phase 2 and 3 sounds and talked about generating a sentence.

Literacy: We talked about how to form a sentence and wrote our own rules for Paradise Wildlife Park. Key Vocabulary: rules, sentence, capital letter, full stop.

Numeracy:

We focused on addition by rolling the dice choosing a number and adding two numbers together. Key Vocabulary: add, amount, count, altogether, total.

Topic:

We started learning about our new topic 'Why do zebras have stripes', and watched a video all about the Massai people from Kenya and discussed the similarities and differences between our culture and theirs.

We had an opportunity to practice African dance and took turns playing the drums
