This week in Reception we learnt about...

<u>Phonics:</u> We all practised different sounds. Miss Godfrey's group (ng ch, sh) Miss Cantwell's group (ure,air) and sentence substitution.

Literacy: We invented a story using story baskets we chose a character, setting, problem and solution for our story. In groups we made a plan for our story then throughout the week the children wrote the beginning, middle and end of the story. Some of the children retold the story they had invented.

Numeracy: We focused on number recognition and we learnt about 2D and 3D shapes.

Topic: We finished our topic 'Why do zebras have stripes?' and talked about what we had learnt and decided on a new role play area relating to our topic 'What do we see in summer?'
