Reading

Please check your child's book bag at the end of each day for letters/forms/homework. Please ensure your child brings their reading wallet to school everyday so that we are able to hear them read. Please continue to read with your child daily and record a comment into the reading record (see inside your child's reading record for guidance). When books need to be changed please ensure the wallet is placed in the 'change me' tray.



Home Learning

Please support your child with their home learning, whilst also encouraging them to become independent learners.

Spellings will be sent home each half term and the children will be tested on a Thursday.

Home Learning Books are sent home on Friday and must be returned on Wednesday. We will be sending home Maths or English homework every week plus a creative task. Please help your child to do their homework each week as it will really support them with their learning at school.

Year 2 must be practicing their 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
