## This Week:

**English...** We have been learning to write our own setting descriptions using adjectives and sentence openers such as adverbs. After learning about the Magic Paintbrush and its setting we chose our own setting and described it using expanded noun phrases.

**Maths...** We have been learning about bar graphs and have collected different data to create our own bar graphs i.e. favourite fruit or colour. We have also been practising addition on a number line.

**Topic:** This week the children have finished researching about harbours and have planned and made their harbours using the materials they brought it. They have really enjoyed planning and building their harbours and have learnt to evaluate and make improvements.
