This Week:

English... This week we have been innovating our own versions of 'Lazy Jack'. We have been thinking about improving our language and sentence structure through conjunctions and adjectives.

Maths: This week in maths we have been learning to use estimation to check our answers. We have been practising a range of addition and subtraction problems and checked these with our estimated answers.

Topic: We have been using our visit from the bug man to help us create our very own minibeast fact files. We have shared our previous home learning to add information to these factfiles.

Next Week:

English... We will be completing our Lazy Jack stories and using our learning to write a character description. We will also be learning how to edit and redraft our writing in order to improve it.
