Homework will be given out every Friday. We will give the children a task with an aim or learning objective that they should reach by the following Wednesday, when homework is to be handed in. We encourage the children to be creative and present their work in any of the following ways:

- Pop-up work
- Diagrams

Maths

Maths homework will be a consolidation/challenge of the work completed in class during the week.

Spellings

A set of spellings according to your child's needs will be worked on at school during the week and then given for homework on a Friday. Spelling tests will be on a Wednesday.

Reading

Children are expected to read to an adult every night. Please record this in your child's Reading Record.

Uniform



We hope you have all enjoyed your Easter break and are excited about your learning in this new and final term.

English

Fiction: Setting descriptions based on quest stories using 'Lady Astrid's Quest' for inspiration.

Non-Fiction: Non-Chronological report about volcanoes.

Poetry—Haikus and Kennings about animals.

Maths

Shape

Identify and describe 2d and 3d shapes.

Money

Recognise value of coins. Add and subtract amounts of money to find change.

Time

Reads and tells the time using both analogue and digital clocks in hours, minutes and seconds.

Tells the time in 12 and 24 hour clock using am and pm. Use and understand vocabulary such as o'clock, morning, afternoon, noon and midnight.

Topic

Tremors- through History, Geography, Art and D&T children will be finding out about what happened in Pompeii, Italy, the Earth's layers, the location of volcanoes within the 'Ring of Fire' and designing and making their own volcanoes.

Science

Animals including Humans— focusing on diet and eating habits. Looking at skeletons and muscles.

Computing
