English: The children learnt to write a persuasive letter using the text 'The Day the Crayons Quit' for inspiration. They wrote to blue crayon using flattery, opinion, hyperbole, rhetorical questions and emotive language.

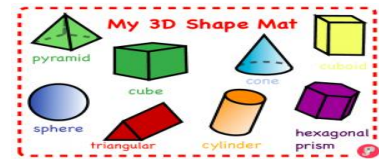
RE: This week the children learnt about the Easter Story and used pictures to retell the story in their own words.
