English: The children made their own set of cards for Top Trumps based on chocolate bars. Then they wrote their own instructions on how to play the game and edited them to ensure all the features had been included.

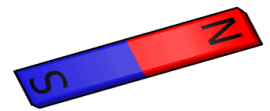
Maths: The children started to use their knowledge of multiplying and dividing to solve every day problems.

English: We will continue writing instructions. This time based on their own creation of a magic potion.

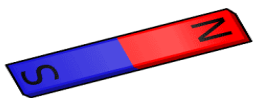
Maths: We will start to show different types of data in tally charts, pictograms and bar charts as part of the data handling topic.
