Maths: Children have been given fractions worksheet to complete.

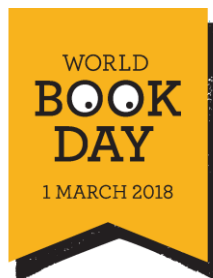
English: Interview a family member and write down the responses using correct speech punctuation.
