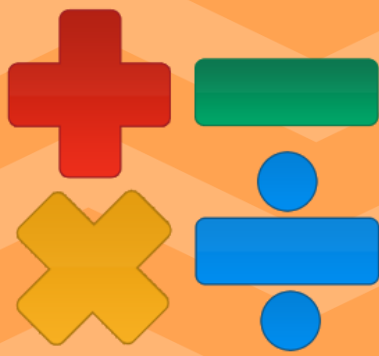

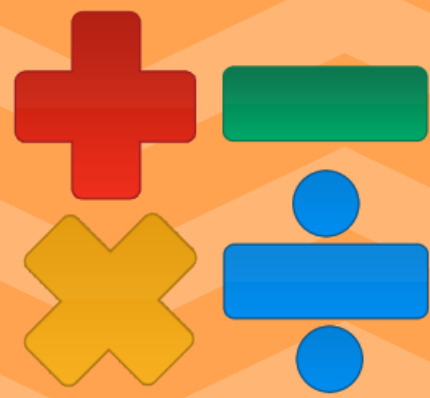

It is important that pupils continue to revise the four operations in maths. Have a go at the challenges below.

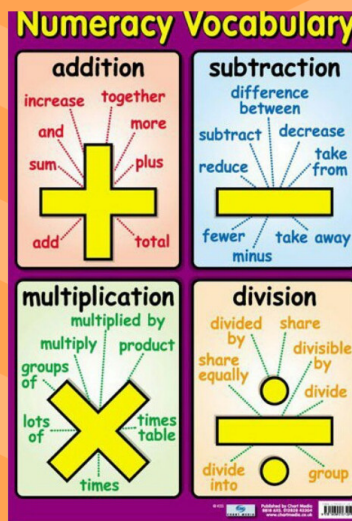
