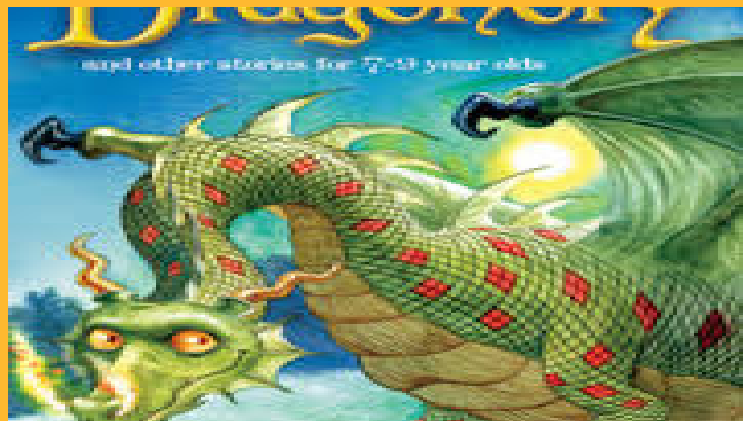

No one mourns the wicked!

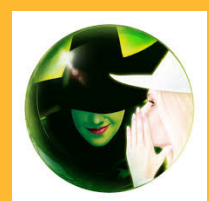
So we got to bring her!
