In maths this week we have been developing our understanding of statistics. This has involved us looking at, and interpreting, different ways of displaying data such as pie charts, pictograms and scatter graphs. We also looked at different terminology associated with data such as mean and mode and how to calculate these.

This week in English we began writing our next portfolio piece based on information texts. We had to imagine we were an owner of an unusual animal called a miptor which we have become experts on as we have cared for this animal for a long time. Using this expert knowledge, we are going to write a guide for looking after a miptor.
