Reading

Please check your child's book bag at the end of each day for letters/forms/homework. Please ensure your child brings their reading wallet to school everyday so that we are able to hear them read. Please continue to read with your child daily and record a comment into the reading record (see inside your child's reading record for guidance). When books need to be changed please ensure the wallet is placed in the 'change me' tray.



Home Learning
