Homework

Homework will be given out every Friday. We will give the children a task with an aim or learning objective that they should reach by the following Wednesday, when homework is to be handed in. We encourage the children to be creative and present their work in any of the following ways:

- Written
- Fold out charts
- Images
- Pop-up work
- Diagrams

Maths

Maths homework will be a consolidation /challenge of the work completed in class during the week.

Spellings

A set of spellings according to your child's needs will be worked on at school during the week and then given for homework on a Friday. Spelling tests will be on a Monday.

Reading

Children are expected to read every night.

Uniform

As with the rest of the school, we expect that Year 4 will follow the uniform policy. It is essential that smart, black shoes are worn as a part of this.

PE kits form a part of what is expected of the children's uniform. Flat shoes are also essential. With 1 PE sessions a week, we suggest the kit is brought in on a Monday and taken home on a Friday each week.

We have an extensive range of after school clubs run by teachers and external coaches. For any club, the children should wear either the school uniform or PE kit, with the addition of sports specific footwear.

Jewellery

Nail polish and jewellery should not be worn at school. Only small studded earrings are allowed and watches may be worn.

If your child is absent from school, please phone the office and send in a letter to the Class Teacher ASAP stating the reason. Holidays must not be taken during term time.

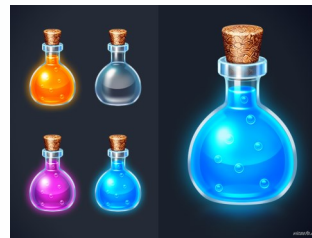
