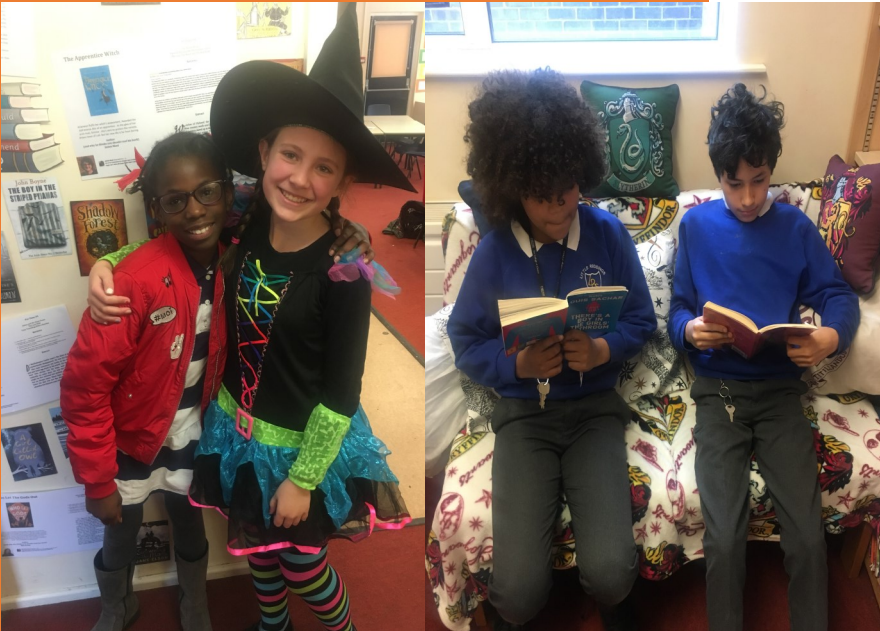


# Year 6 Newsletter
