Dear Parents/Carers,

This week in Reception we learnt about...

Phonics: We revised phase 2 and 3 sounds and practised our phase 3 tricky words.

Literacy: We created a class story map and story books of 'Monkey Puzzle'
We learnt about how to tell a story using the correct language and wrote sentences describing settings and characters.

Numeracy: We focused on putting numbers in order to 20 and recognising teen numbers.

Topic:

In topic we displayed pictures showing a range of animals that live in Africa discussed what they look like and listed some adjectives about the animals. We offered children a range of African animal puppets and asked each child to choose a puppet and name the animal. We challenged the children to think of something their animal might say. For example 'I am a lion, and I have a mane of hair' or 'I am a zebra, I like eating leaves'.

This is what Reception will be learning about next week:

We are going to invent our own stories and create a class story book.

- Practise tricky words they, was, said, little, children.
- Can you write a sentence using one or two words and share it in front of the class.
