This Week:

English... We have been assessing their progress using SATs practice tests. The children have completed practice comprehension tests.

Maths... We have been assessing their progress using SATs practice tests. The children have completed both arithmetic and reasoning practice. The reasoning tests include problem solving and provide an opportunity for the children to explain how they have reached their answers.

Topic: This week the children have finished researching and written up their notes on their Jamaica topic. They have been learning about their culture and famous people who come from there. This will continue until we can make a booklet of information.

The children have worked very hard this week when practicing their SATs tests.
